



Houston Golf Association Junior Golf Program Request for Financial Aid

ELIGIBILITY

The HGA Junior Golf Program is open to boys and girls ages 12 through 18. The junior's age on August 14, 2018 is the determination for eligibility throughout the season. Those juniors who have graduated from high school may only play the season directly following high school graduation regardless of age.

Boys and girls are grouped into the following age brackets and will compete within designated yardages.
